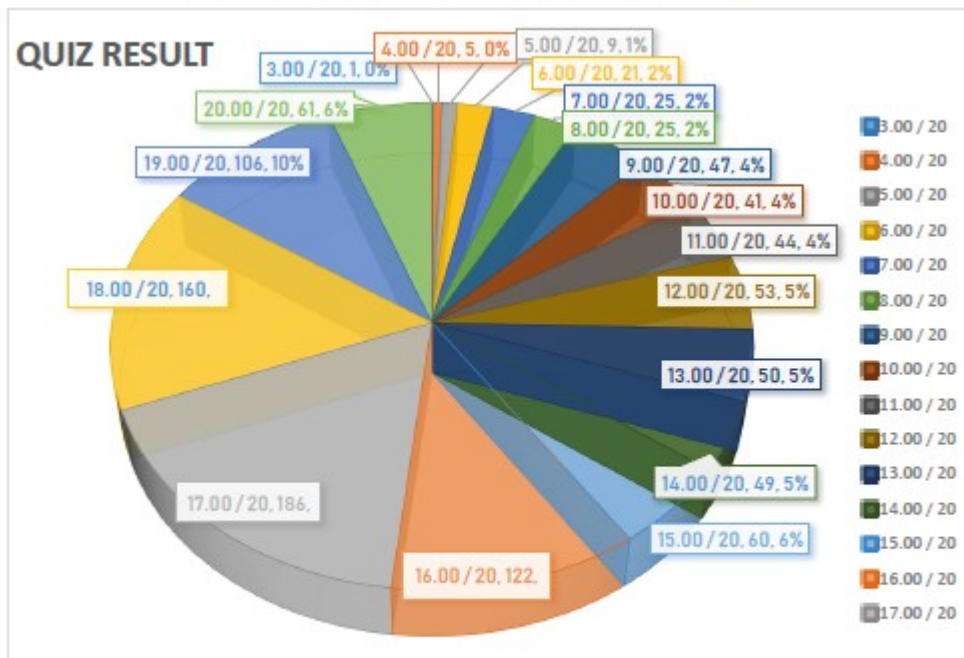

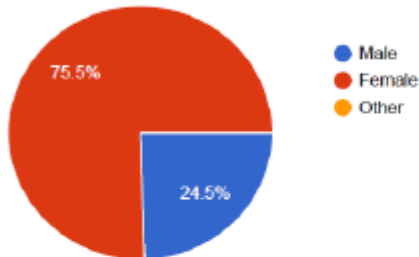


The Result analysis is shown below in the form of pie chart



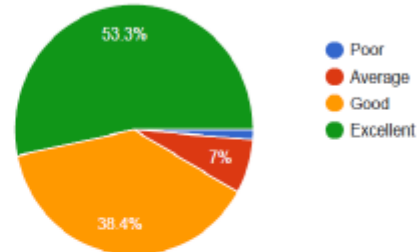
### Gender
