
Activity 2: International Opportunities after Graduation



The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Maharashtra College of Arts, Science & Commerce and Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Centre for Post Graduate Studies & Research in association with the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trade Marks, Government of India organized Intellectual Property Rights Awareness Program under National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) on 21st September, 2022.

Intellectual property rights (IPR) refers to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/creation for a given period of time.

Universities and public research institutions are among the direct contributors towards innovation and research, particularly in emerging economies. Off late, the significance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in higher education has been widely recognized. The principal of the college Dr. Sirajuddin Chougle reflected on the significance of Universities and public research institutions as direct contributors towards innovation and research, particularly in emerging economies. He further added, the potential pool of talent for innovation in these economies also emanates largely from educational institutions and research institutions; hence, the need of the time is to recognise Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in higher educations.



India is a large consumer credit market and it's such an untapped market. Being the world's largest producer of milk at 190 million tonnes in 2019, growing at over 40% over the last seven years. Tolearn more about the making of milk products, students were taken to~ Verka Milk Plant, Chandigath.

Students learnt how a milk processing plant works?



Dr. Amritpal Singh Dy. Manager took charge and explained to the students.

The entire process can be categorized into different steps. Milk is initially collected from the cattle in large farms and it is then checked for purity and quality. It is then transported to the plants where it is transferred to huge tanks. The milk is then separated and clarified. It is essential to separate bacteria and other contaminants from the milk to make it fit for consumption. After the clarification process, it is then processed again to separate fullcream milk and toned milk. The process of segregation is followed by the addition of fortified minerals and vitamins in the milk. The product is then made ready for pasteurization. In the processof pasteurization, the milk is heated to a very high temperature and then cooled immediately to eliminate bacteria.

The pasteurized milk is then homogenized to remove the fat content from the milk.

Homogenization is quite essential as it helps to eliminate fat particles in the product. There are varioustypes of milk products made available quite easily through bothonline and offline store.

It is then packaged and sold to the consumer markets. Most of these packages include shelf life and expiry dates. Milk products are available in different forms depending on the degree of fat inthem. Most of these products can be bought from online stores too. This is how the entire cow farming in India is carried out.

Today, there are various companies which offer substantial assistance to processing plants to procure and process milk inhygienic methods within a short period of time.

With the development of automated processing plants, it is easierto monitor the delivery of milk from the tankers and finally to the packets and bottles. Various technologies are being integrated in the automation process to further enhance the functions of the processing plants. Different automation applications are integrated into a single application through modern technologies. Different programs are initiated to reduce the time consuming process of cleaning the processing plants which is an integral part of the industry. With the right type of applications, it is easier for the dairy industry to deliver quality products on time. By seeing skyscrapers in Mumbai, students were fascinated to see how the very fundamental thing which is used in the making of buildings is being produced right in front of them.

The students bombarded the owner with the foremost questions.

How are Bricks Made?

Bricks can be made from various raw materials like clay, calciumsulfate, granite, mud, marble, shale, concrete etc. They are prepared using sand, water and additives to make clay. The mixture is then placed into molds and cut up in sizes as per the requirement. Bricks, therefore, differ in the temperature they are fired at and many other factors. The standard size of the bricks is 14" X 10" X 4". With technology advancing every couple of years, bricks are now produced easily in mass quantities. There are DIY(Do-it-yourself) machines available that can help you make around 3000 bricks a day.

Upon asking about the production cost of manufacturing bricks. The owner, explained Brick manufacturing needs a vast expanse of land and the cost of equipment and raw material. An average of INR 12-15 Lakh is required to get the land in place, with the machinery, chimney and other equipment, including labor and additional costs. This work is intensive and requires working long hours in a dusty environment. To summarize, here are the essential factors that determine the cost of a brick making business.
