The NCC ARMY wing of MAHARASHTRA COLLEGE UNIT, MUMBAI. Celebrated 77 th Independence Day.

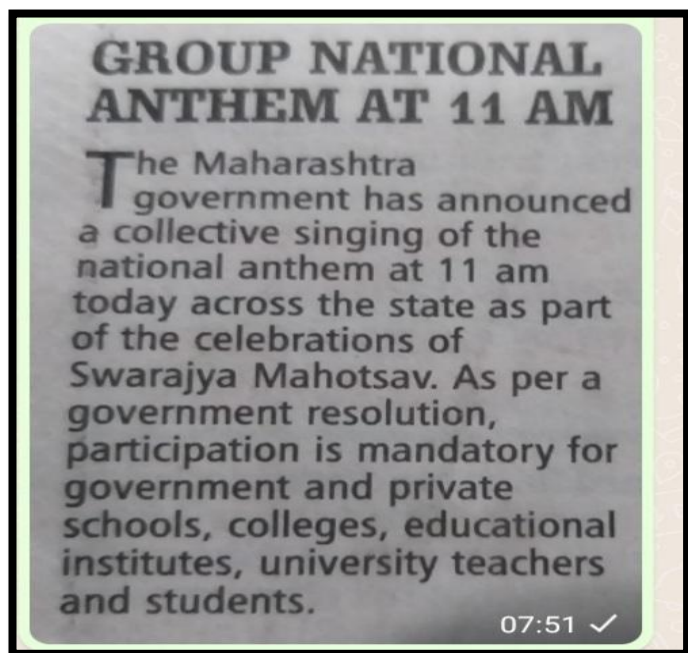

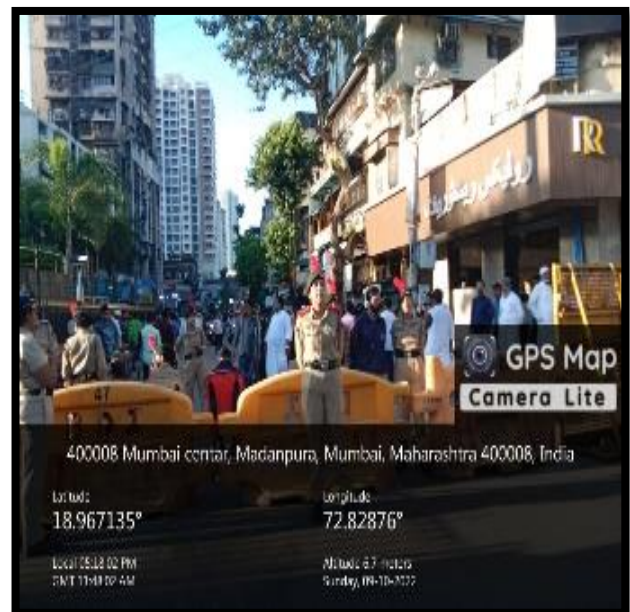

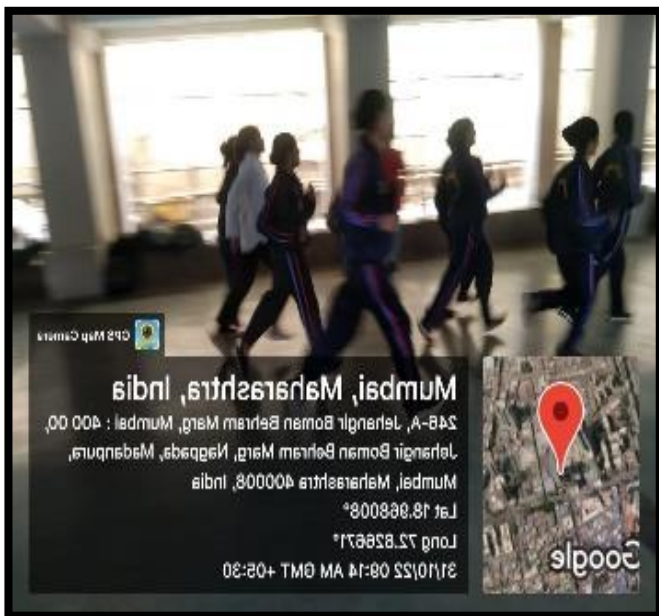
