

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WHEREAS, FIRST PARTY is a college and it is in a field of providing undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in Commerce, Arts, Science and Ph. D Research Center.

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WHEREAS, SECOND PARTY is a college and it is in a field of providing undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in Commerce and Management.

WHEREAS, FIRST PARTY AND SECOND PARTY are entitled to jointly organize training programme, skill based programme, seminars, workshop, faculty development programmes for the students as well as teaching faculty and sharing the infrastructure and know-how.

AND WHEREAS the College has shown interest to have the college tie-up with Second Party to enable the college to impart training in the courses like Share Market Training, Job oriented training, Webinars, Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, Students and Teachers related activities from the both college premises;

AND WHEREAS "NSS College of Commerce and Economics, Tardeo, Mumbai-400034" has agreed to jointly organize Training programme, Skill based programme, Webinars, Seminars, Workshop, Faculty development programmes for the students as well as teaching faculty and sharing the infrastructure and know-how.

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NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES AND MUTUAL COVENANTS AND PROMISES MADE HEREINAFTER THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS –

1. DEFINITIONS:

- 1.1. The term "Commencement" shall mean the date of signing of MOU.
- The term "Centre" shall mean the Classrooms/Lab at College premises.
- 1.3. The term "Month" shall mean a calendar month and "Year" shall mean an academic year.

2. RESPONSIBILITY:

FIRST PARTY:

- 2.1. The College shall be sharing infrastructure or basic facilities to conduct curricular and co-curricular activities for the students and teachers.
- 2.2. The College shall be expected to render full support and co-operation during the functioning of the various activities between both colleges.
- 2.3. The College and Second PARTY will jointly maintain the attendance of students.

SECOND PARTY:

- 2.1. The College shall be sharing infrastructure or basic facilities to conduct curricular and co-curricular activities for the students and teachers.
- 2.2. The College shall be expected to render full support and co-operation during the functioning of the various activities between both colleges.
- 2.3. The College and Second Party will jointly maintain the attendance of students.

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3. MANPOWER:

3.1. The Managerial and Non-Teaching staff required for the activities shall be provided by the both College.

4. VALIDITY:

- 4.1. This MOU shall come into force from the date of signing and will be valid for 3 (Three) year from there onwards.
- 4.2 Negotiations as to any extension of this MOU of another 3 years to the terms of any such extension shall be taken up one (1) month prior to the expiry of this MOU subject to the approval of the Governing Body of the both College. The MOU shall stand NULL & VOID thereupon.

5. TERMINATION:

- 5.1. Except or otherwise provided, this MOU can be terminated by a 3 months prior written notice by either party during the tenure of contract.
- 5.1.1. Upon the breach of one or more of its obligations hereunder, provided that this MOU shall not be terminated if the defaulting Party has cured the default within thirty (30) day after the notice has been given.
- 5.1.2. Upon either Party transferring the whole or any important PARTY of its business or.
- 5.1.3. Upon either Party merging with or becoming controlled directly or indirectly by any company or entity not agreeable with the other.

6. ARBITRATION:

Any dispute or differences, which may arise out of this MOU or in the institution there are, included any dispute relating to its validity or effect shall be settled under the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996.

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7. JURISDICTION:

All Legal Matters will be heard and settled in the City of Mumbai Jurisdiction only.

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding(hereinafter referred to as MoU) is entered into on Monday, 3rd July 2023 by and between MAHARSHI DAYANAND COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE. MAHARASHTRA COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE, KIRTI M.DOONGURSEE COLLEGE OF ARTS. SCIENCE & COMMERCE, Bhavan's Hazarimal Somani College and MES's The D.G.Ruparel College of Arts, Science and Commerce from Mumbai and affiliated to University of Mumbai.

The aforesaid institutes are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as Institutes

Purpose:

The MoU sets the terms and understanding between the five Institutes in order to undertake programmes that will encourage students of Mathematics

- to create a quest for knowledge in Mathematics
- to be able to think critically
- to put across their ideas effectively in problem solving
- to develop an interest for research

Objectives of MoU:

- a) To promote and enhance mutual cooperation of Academic Interest between these Institutes.
- b) To establish faculty and student exchange programmes between these institutes
- c) To provide technical assistance for enhancement of quality of education at these institutes including usage of ICT facilities.
- d) To promote research/continuing education, curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities between Institutes.

Technical areas of collaboration:

- Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures at these Institutes on
- Provide necessary help and collaborations wherever applicable in organizing conferences / seminars / workshops / and personality development / life skill b)

programmes / FDP between Institutes for enhancement of skills for staff and

- Cooperate in activities such as placements, Job-Mela programmes, etc. (0)
- Mutual co-operation between IQACs of the Institutes. d)

Proposed modes of collaboration:

The Institutes propose to collaborate through the following:

- Co-operation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interests and any other appropriate mode of interaction beneficial to the institutes.
- A specific plan where needed and necessary will be worked out by the Institutes depending upon requirements and availability of resources.

Terms and Conditions:

- This MoU is not a commitment of funds. But all the institutes will singularly or jointly source funds based on their strengths, technical preparedness and legalities
- For visits related to advice and consultancy, travel and other expenses will be borne b) by institutes equally.
- The faculty members and students can use the library facility and exchange the interest for the same.
- The institutes agree to help, identify and invite faculty members and researchers d) from other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses and as advisory/organizing committee members. e)
- To give preference to staff and student participants of the Institutes f)
- This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Institutes at any time.
- Either institute shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior g) written notice to the other institute. M)
- On mutual consent of all the Institutes, review meetings will be conducted once in three months with Co-coordinators and Principals.

Confidentiality:

The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the period of the MoU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

The above confidential clause under this MoU excludes the information/data possessed by either Institute before entering into the MoU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

Duration of MoU:

This MoU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institutes, shall expire in Three years after the effective data specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MoU shall be extended for another Three years by mutual consent.

Co-ordinators:

The Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and

Intellectual Property Rights:

The Intellectual Property Rights(IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activities. collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two Institutes.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish
 channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their
 respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
- First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to the second party in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 7. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
- 8. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending technologies.
- 9. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the student internships of second party on various trending technologies of minimum four weeks duration.
- 10. ExcelR will reach out to students to communicate about course details, webinars, blogs, industry events etc., which will be informative or promotional in nature.
- 11. Training & Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party & affiliated colleges and employees of both the organizations.
- 12. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party

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13. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 14. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 15. Curriculum Design: First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 16. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the trainings to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development
- 17. Skill Development Programs: First Party to train the students of second Party on the emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 18. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 19. Faculty Development Programs: First Party to train the faculties of second Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 20. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 21. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation.

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- 22. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.
- 23. In case, second party wants to conduct customized commercial trainings then this agreement can be amend/adding annexure with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 24. The first party will have the sole rights on the curriculum and related content provided in the trainings and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of the first party.
- 25. Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 26. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this agreement
- 27. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or cancelled by either party any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

28. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.



Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Mumbai - 400 008 and Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai - 600 097. This Memorandum of Understanding is executed at Chennai on 11/02/2021 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.

Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce affiliated to University of Mumbai, was established in 1968 with a vision to bring higher education to the

door steps of the economically underprivileged students, especially belonging to the Muslim minority, emphasizing on their all-round development. It is managed by Khairul Islam Higher Education Society, which was founded under the able guidance of it's Honourable President, Dr.Rafiq Zakaria, a veteran parliamentarian, writer, educationist and Islamic scholar. Since last five decades, Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce has remained a pioneer institution in the Muslim locality of South Mumbai and has played a pivotal role in bringing the cultural change within the community through imparting value-based education. The college has been re- accredited with B++ grade by NAAC with CGPA of 2.88. Apart from regular degree courses of B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com., the college also offers various certificate courses and post graduate courses in Management, Botany and Information Technology. The college is also a recognized research centre in the subjects of Urdu, Business Policy and Administration, and Botany. Emphasis is given to provide equal opportunities for every student to explore their talent not only in academics but also in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The college provides congenial environment for both the students and faculty, and consistently encourages them to widen their capabilities enabling them to become responsible citizens of India.

II. And the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University is an exclusive University for Teacher Education established in 2008, by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Act No 33 of 2008) to promote excellence in Teacher Education. This University is unique in nature relatively to the other Universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society and the nation at large, with six Departments of Study and Research, namely: Department of Pedagogical Sciences, Department of Value Education, Department of Educational Psychology, Department of Educational Technology, Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation, and Department of Educational Planning and Administration. Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University produces M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. Scholars every year through the

University Departments as well as through its affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu.

1. Purpose and Objectives:

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of students and teachers. Hence, the parties desire to work together with the following objectives:

- 1.1 To conduct and organize students' interchanging/intercultural programme integrations without financial dependencies.
- 1.2. To create job opportunities, global openings and other possibilities without any financial dependencies.
- 1.3. To encourage the Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and others to participate and contribute as resource faculty for Webinars, Seminars, Mentoring Programmes, etc.
- 1.4. To establish a global stage for the students and teachers.
- 1.5. To strengthen the educational relationships between Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce, and Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University for the welfare of the students and teachers.

2. Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the General Secretary, Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce.
- 2.2. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.

- 2.3. The Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each institution may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the partner.
- 2.4. The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes via video conference / face to face based on everyone's availability.

COMMUNITY AGREEMENT BETWEEN

HERE SOLUTIONS INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED AND MAHARASHTRA COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE AND COMMERCE

- CONFIDENTIALITY. All communications, information exchange and personal data (such as email adresses or user statistics) shall be treaded confidentially and shall not be shared, or distributed to, third parties without prior written consent.

4. LIMITATION ON LIABILITY.

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (herein after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 5th day of May month 2022 (Date 05-05-2022), by and between **ExcelR Solutions**,

And

(Here in after referred to as 'Second Party')
(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.



- 1.3 Intellectual Property Rights shall mean all worldwide intellectual property rights, including without limitation, copyrights, trademarks, service marks, know-how and all other proprietary rights, whether registered or unregistered.

- Mutual co-operation between IQAC's of both Institutes. d)

Proposed modes of collaboration: 3.

Smt. K. G. Mittal College and Maharashtra College propose to collaborate through the following:

- Co-operation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interests and any other appropriate mode of interaction a) beneficial to both the institutes.
- A specific plan where needed and necessary will be worked out by the Institutes depending upon requirements and availability of resources. b)

Terms and Conditions: 4.

For continuing education to teachers and students, the financial arrangements will be made as per the mutually agreed terms without a) any profit.

b) For the visits related advice and consultancy, travel and other expenses of both the faculty shall be financed by Parent College,

The faculty members and students can use the library facility and

exchange the interest for the same,

- and researchers from the other institute to participate in conferences, workshops and short term courses and as advisory/organizing committee members.
- e) To give preference to staff and student participants of either institutes.
- 1) This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the institutes at any time,
- g) Either institute shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other institute.
- h) On mutual consent of both the Institutes, review meetings will be conducted once in three months with Co-coordinators and Principals.

The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the performance of the MoU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

The above confidential clause under this MoU excludes the information/data possessed by either institute before entering into the MoU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

6. Duration of MoU:

This MoU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institutes, shall expire in <u>Two</u> years after the effective data specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MoU shall be extended for another <u>Two</u> years by mutual consent.

7. Co-ordinators:

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

8. Intellectual Property Rights:

The Intellectual Property Rights(IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case


