Action Taken Report on Feedback 2021 – 22

Action taken on Feedback from Students:

1. The syllabus of all the subjects is drafted by the Board of Studies, University of Mumbai. Yet, a good response was received from the students with respect to the professional and entrepreneurship skills acquired through it.
2. Teachers were motivated to provide online resources and notes as study materials.
3. The library is updated from time to time to incorporate books and journals as per the updated syllabus.
4. Mock Tests were conducted to familiarize students with the virtual mode of examinations. Offline exams were conducted for the First-Year students as per the instructions from the University of Mumbai. Additional 15 minutes per hour were given to the students and the papers were scheduled with a gap of two days between papers.
5. The Training and Placement Cell collaborated with organizations such as Toothsi, Accenture, Clover Infotech, etc. to enhance job opportunities for students.
6. Admission process and payment of fees were simplified and assistance was provided to the students for the same.
7. Book Bank Scheme was continued even during the pandemic.


Action taken on Feedback from Teachers:
