Types of Marine Pollution
Eutrophication/Nutrient Pollution

The diagram illustrates the process of eutrophication in a cross-section of a body of water over time. It shows the sun, surface water, phytoplankton, zooplankton, and sediment. The process is divided into five numbered steps:

- Nutrient load up:** Excess nutrients from fertilizers are washed from the land into rivers or lakes for irrigation.
- Phytoplankton:** These microscopic plants multiply and grow of algae, diatoms and other plants.
- Algal blooms:** Algae in degraded water become so dense that they block out other plants. The plants die and rot in the water in thousands.
- Decomposition:** Bacteria (saprophytes) break down the dead plants and bacteria, using up most of the oxygen in the water.
- Death of the ecosystem:** Oxygen levels reach a point where no life is possible. Fish and other organisms die.
