




More than 50 students from B.A/B.Sc./B.COM streams attended this program. 3 students were benefited after they joined this academy.

5) Workshop on IoT


The Department of Computer Science and Information technology has organised a one day workshop on 4th August, 2017 at the Department. The experts from Edkits Electronics solutions were called in for their expertise. Namely Mr. Shah, Mr B.M Prajapati were experts who conducted the sessions. The entire workshop was conducted at department Lab L2. The Department has always believed in a practical learning-based approach embedded with ethical values. Hence, the main objective of the workshop was to provide introduction to Internet of Things (IoT), to give exposure to various sub-fields and technology stacks of IoT and to enable people to convert their IoT product idea into a working prototype. The department is persistently committed to providing technical knowledge with high employability skills. To fulfil the gap between industry and academia the department had planned this hand on sessions in collaboration with Edkits. According to the statistics it is estimated that by 2020 the market cap of IOT would be around 1.7 Trillion dollars. It is no secret that India is an emerging player in the communications industry with the tenfold increase in mobile phones and electronics usages in the last few years. As per LinkedIn, IOT will be the most sought after skills by 2021. Total 80 students have participated in this workshop. During this session students had an exposure to various contents relating to IoT. The participants understood the concept of IoT, sensors and actuators used in IoT applications. They were taught about architecture and cloud services and data analytics and students were made aware about various protocols, raspberry pi, security features of IoT, hands on sessions and troubleshooting of problems.

6) Report on Workshop on Mapping Technology

A workshop on Mapping Technology was conducted by the Departments of Computer Science and Information Technology on the 9th of March 2018 in collaboration with HereMaps. The workshop started with the introduction of the Resource Person and later Mr Arfaz introduced key concepts on mapping; defining critical terms, capabilities as well as current limitations of mapping tools. The sessions also included multimedia resources to better elucidate key concepts. The key concepts were introduced from the absolute basics as this workshop was designed to cater to participants of F.Y class with any skill level in coding. Multiple simplified examples and use cases were explained. The students showed keen interest in the workshop and have gained hands-on experience in the topics of mapping and dataset. REPORTS OF DEPARTMENT WORKSHOP AND SYMPOSIA

1) Report on "Founder's Day-International Interdisciplinary Symposium on Blue-Economy versus Blue-Water economy"

The one-day International Interdisciplinary Symposium was organized by Department of Biological Sciences, KIHE Society's, Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce in collaboration with Sindhu Swadyay Sanstha (SSS), University of Mumbai, Mumbai, on occasion of the Founder's Day on 7th January 2019. The program was conducted under the guidance of the Shri. Vinayak V. Dalvie (Co-ordinator, SSS) and Capt. Dr. Akbar A. Dalvi (Head, Department of Zoology) and Dr. A. Q. Ansari (Vice-Principal and Head, Department of Botany). Staff members from the Botany and Zoology department worked as organising committee members for the said program. The main goal of the program is to sensitise the students from various disciplines such as botany, zoology, economics, geography, fishery, earth sciences, management to pursue a career in blue economy and allied field. Moreover, in order to promote research in the above-mentioned fields and to shed light on career opportunities in this field.

The guest speaker for the symposium was Prof. V.N Attri, Chair in Indian Ocean Studies (CIOS) at the IORA Secretariat, University of Mauritius. Prof. V. N. Attri has occupied the position of Chair in Indian Ocean Studies (CIOS), Indian Ocean Rim Association (IORA) since November 2014. His duties are to foster research activities and studies in fields of interest to IORA with a view to evolving realistic programs of regional cooperation. The areas of study are Marine Resources, Trade and Commerce, Trade Liberalization, Trade and Investment Facilitation, Sustainable Development, Science and Technology, and the Blue Economy. Prof Attri has, therefore, been contributing to all the six priority areas and two cross-cutting focus areas of IORA.

The Program started at 2.30 pm and completed at 4.30 pm. The symposium was inaugurated by reciting the Holy-Quran, followed by the inaugural address by Dr. U. R. Singh, Assi. Prof. in Zoology. Welcome speech was delivered by Dr. A. Q. Ansari, Vice-Principal and Head, Department of Botany. He emphasises on the need of such kind symposiums for the upgradation of the students' knowledge and career advancement. This was followed by the felicitation of the guest speaker and dignitaries by the hands of Prof. Dr. Haji Kalaniya (General Secretory, KIHE Society) with a shawl and bouquet. This was followed by the talk by Dr. V. N. Magre, Principal, Kirti College & Pro-Vice Chancellor, SNDT university. Following felicitation, Shri. Vinayak V. Dalvie, Coordinator of SSS, University of Mumbai delivered a

speech and especially focused on the active role of SSS is in the value of education in rural students, providing education without any fees, and promoting rural talent for research. Prof. Dr. Haji Kalaniya (General Secretory, KIHE Society) reminded the contribution of the founders in setting and shaping this institute.

Following the inaugural session, Prof. B. G. Kulkarni, Ex-BOS Chairman, Ex-Director, Institute of Science, Guest faculty at University of Mauritus, the participants were introduced to the guest speaker and also explained how IORA is contributing towards the economic growth of the participating nations.

This was followed by the Guest speaker, Prof. V. N. Attri. He started the lecture by explaining the structure of the IORA, functioning of IORA and participating countries. He also explained how several countries are trying very hard so as to get the highest economic benefits from the ocean resources. He further stressed on the active participation of youth, especially in the research related to the Blue-economy and sustainable development. At the end of the talk the interaction with the audience was quite fruitful.

More than 27 faculty from other nearby colleges participated in the said program. Almost all (45) faculties from Maharashtra College participated in the said program. In total, 84 students from Maharashtra College and other institutes such as Mithibai College, Kelkar College, M.D. Colleges from various departments such as zoology, botany, economics and other disciplines participated. Students were either undergraduate or postgraduate level. The smooth conduction of programs required helping hands, which is provided by NCC cadets and NSS volunteers. 17 NCC cadets from Maharashtra College, 5 from Rizwi College and 25 NSS volunteers participated in the program.

A formal closing session was conducted by Capt. Dr. Akbar A. Dalvi by delivering the vote of thanks. The program ended with the National Anthem followed by refreshment and certificate distribution. 2) Workshop On Mental Health








1) GO DIGITAL: FREE DIGITAL MARKETING COURSE



4) National Workshop on 'Review of Literature for Research'







6) Webinar on Career Counselling, Public Speaking and Personality Development





7) E workshop on Microsoft's Cloud Platform






Diagrammatic representation of the success of the Webinar on Microsoft cloud Platform.

8) E-Workshop on Python Programming in collaboration with NIIT





The talk was furthered by Questions and Answer Session where Mr. Manoj Abraham addressed the queries of the participants. 




11) Teaching & Research Opportunities for Arts Students





21) Tracing the Impact of Covid-19 Pandemic on Social, Economic, Political and Psychological Conditions in India: Challenges for 21st Century'

Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce & Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Centre for Post-Graduate Studies and Research, Mumbai, organised a multidisciplinary E-National Conference on 'Tracing the Impact of Covid-19 Pandemic on Social, Economic, Political and Psychological Conditions in India: Challenges for 21st Century' on 5th April, 2021. The conference which was actually conceptualised by Social Science Departments of the college began by recitation of verses from the Quran. Prof Mujahid Khan of Department of Arabic and Islamic Studies recited the verses and also narrated its translation in English. Prof Asema Siddiqui of Department of Economics who was hosting the conference along with Prof Misbah Karbhari of the same department, invited Prof M. Z. Shahid of Department of Political Science and also the Convenor of the conference to talk about the objective and concept of the conference.

While talking about the objective and concept of the conference, Prof Shahid informed the virtual audience that the preliminary discussion about the e-national conference began in January, 2021. The idea of several disciplines of social sciences coming together to organise the conference helped in understanding the multi-dimensional nature of the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on human life. He also talked about the dominance of the word 'e' with increasing digitisation of the formal work processes. It is acquiring more and more relevance with the social distancing being practised as a necessary norm in the life of the human population. The reality of being virtual has been gaining acceptance world-wide. He further pointed out that being skilled at technology was almost the necessity of life today.

While elaborating on the rationale behind the theme for the conference, Prof Shahid said that the Coronavirus better known as Covid-19 has created the first global civil emergency of the 21st century. It has caused unprecedented devastation, loss of human life and economic disruption worldwide. The far-reaching impact of the disease on social, economic, political, and psychological conditions in India is still being assessed. With the surge and resurgence of infections in various parts of India, newer dimensions of the disease are emerging, and stories of frustration and desolation are being retold with greater anguish.

He further said that the sudden lockdown imposed to combat the disease in India had an impact on all facets of life. It has had significant psychological and social effects on the population, especially the children, college students, working women and health workers. The imposition of social distancing and strict security measures adopted to contain the virus, have affected the relationship among people and their perception of empathy toward others. The involuntary separation from loved ones, loss of freedom, uncertainty about health conditions and losing one's sources of livelihood have created a feeling of helplessness. The large-scale disruption to economic activities in India has adversely affected almost all the sectors of the national economy. It has also given enough reason to the government to deny various freedoms to people and legitimise further an authoritative administration and establish a police state with greater ferocity.

Prof Shahid, while talking about the objective of the conference further said that their endeavour, through the e-conference, is to understand and assess the impact of Covid-19 on social, economic, political and psychological conditions in India. The broader objective of the conference is to gauge the effects and analyse the various measures adopted by the government to deal with the pandemic. In such a situation an e-platform gives the citizenry an additional opportunity to ask questions to those in power. Looking at the enormity of the sufferings caused to the people during the lockdown one is justifiably tempted to ask if it could have been done differently to minimise the damage to the economy and lessen the anguish caused to the people at large. Despite the odds, this is the time to make efforts to deal with the crisis and learn from the sufferings of the people. This is also the time to determine the possible challenges for this century and prepare ourselves to face and confront the consequences.

Principal Dr. Sirajuddin Chougle in his opening remarks emphasised the need to have this kind of academic interactions to clarify our own perception with regard to such pandemic. Dr. Chougle who in fact encouraged the members of the organising committee to organise the conference was quite optimistic about such intellectual exercises. He chose to thanks the keynote speaker and other eminent guests who had joined on line to be part of the conference this morning. Dr Chougle also spoke about the various achievements of Maharashtra College during the last five years and how the college has earned a name for itself.

Dr. Hanif Lakdawala, founder Director, Sanchetana Community Health and Research Centre, Ahmedabad, Gujarat, invited as a key-note speaker began his talk with tracing the history of such pandemics during the last century and how the world faced the consequences and finally dealt with it successfully. He narrated with anguish the sufferings of the people in the country due to sudden lockdown and how the migrant workers were left to fend for themselves. He

talked about various incidents within Ahmedabad during the period and how at Sanchetana they could play a positive role. Dr. Lakdawala also pointed out the futility of the various governmental measures. He also talked about how discrimination is being institutionalised in health care system and people are being left to look for their own solution. Towards the end of the inaugural session, Dr. Karen Miranda, HOD, department of Sociology, thanked the guests.

The inaugural programme was followed by the technical sessions which were virtually categorised as R-1 and R-2 to better facilitate the presentation of research papers received at the conference. The technical session R-1 was chaired by Dr. Gautam Gawli, Professor and Director, Amity Institute of Behavioural and Allied Sciences, Mumbai, and moderated by Dr. Liyaqat Khan, Professor, Department of Civics and Politics, University of Mumbai. The technical session R-1 which was hosted by Professor Asema Siddiqui, had ten participants who presented their research papers.

The technical session R-2 which was digitally designed to run parallel to R-1, was chaired by Dr. Anita Rath, Professor, School of Development Studies, Tata Institute of Social Science (TISS), Mumbai, and moderated by Dr. Balaji N. Kendre, Professor & Head, Department of Sociology, University of Mumbai. The technical session R-2 which was hosted by Prof Misbah Karbhari, had 13 participants who presented their research papers.

The valedictory session which was held in the afternoon, began with expert comments and observations from the chairpersons and the moderators who had keenly listened to all the research presentations. The chairpersons and moderators of both R-1 and R-2 were generous in their appreciation for the researchers who had invested so much time energy in fact finding and had managed to present a good analysis from the data they had gathered. The chairpersons and the moderators also chose to offer suggestions and points to be cautiously adhered to while undertaking academic research. In the absence of Dr. Anita Rath in the valedictory session, her observations were read by Dr. Rakhshandah Hani, HOD, Department of Economics and Coordinator of the conference.

The observations on research papers presented at the conference was followed by talks by resource persons especially invited at the virtual conference. Shri Yogesh Mishra, Head, Research Unit, PRAJA, Mumbai, presented a very comprehensive report on 'Impact of Covid-19 in Mumbai' which was prepared after a field research by the PRAJA team. Shri Mishra in his lucid presentation which was full of data and information collected at the grassroot level

pointed out how the measures to contain the virus have been disastrous for the small businesses and the informal sector. He also highlighted the severity of impact of Covid-19 on the life of the urban poor and those who were dependent on daily income from various sources.

Adv. Irfan Engineer, Director, Centre for Study of Society and Secularism (CSSS), Mumbai, in his analytical talk on 'Scapegoating During Coivd-19 Pandemic in India' highlighted how Muslims in general and 'Tablighi Jamat' in particular were blamed with assistance from few media houses for spreading the virus in India. Even in a pandemic like situation attempts were made to communalise the disaster and spread hatred against a particular community. He further said that the tendency to divert the attention from one's own failure and look for a scapegoat is socially disruptive and violative of human rights. It is dangerous for society as it divides the society on communal lines and leads to discriminatory practices even by health workers and hospitals against the community who is declared by media as so called 'super-spreader'. Adv. Irfan Engineer also talked about the report of the CSSS on the topic and highlighted its findings. He pointed out the there is a need for secular forces to unite and prevent such disruptions in future and blame-game against a community without any authentic data and information.

Adv. Irfan Engineer's presentation was followed by the valedictory speech by Dr. Amar Jesani, former, Chief Executive, CEHAT, and the Editor, Indian Journal of Medical Forum for Medical Ethics'. Dr. Jesani, in a very analytical and insightful narrative, questioned various terminologies used in the process of containing the Covid-19. He, for instance, stated that instead of talking about 'physical distancing' the government has imposed 'social distancing' which conveys a different connotation and through this a new form of untouchability is being practised in society. Dr. Jesani said that the fight against the pandemic was important but not by creating a social environment where people start distrusting each other. The attempt to restrict our civil and political rights are being justified on scientific grounds. Instead of bringing about improvement in our health care system people are being locked-down in dictatorial manner. While agreeing that some restrictions are required to contain the virus, it cannot be misused to violate the human rights of the citizens. The decision to impose restrictions must be based on scientific consultation and justified grounds. The idea of curtailing democratic rights to fight the pandemic is undesirable. He also stated that despite the fact that vaccines were urgently needed in India, 60 % of the vaccines had been exported which would lead to shortages in India very soon.

The valedictory session was followed by vote of thanks by Vice Principal Dr. Abdul Majid Ansari who thanked all the guests, delegates from other colleges and the members of the organising committee. The programme ended with the National Anthem.


Screen shot of the webinar on Block chain Technology on 21st Sept, during the resource person's presentation










6) Lecture Series in SRUJAN 22: Some Statistical Solutions to Mathematical problems




- 1. Radiation Quantities, Units and Effects

After the theoretical presentations got over, the Practical and Demonstration sessions were conducted in afternoon on following topics:


- 1. Gammaspectrometry






Prof. Ismail Popatiya explaining Artificial Intelligence during the webinar on 29th September, 2021.

11) Here Maps Internship Program






12) Webinar on Entrepreneurship and Family Managed Business





14) E-Summit on Entrepreneurship and Family Managed Business


