
In response to your letter cited above, it is intimated that permission is hereby granted to your organization for organizing Blood Donation Camp at following stations. Details are as under: -

- 1) The space allotted should not be used for any commercial purpose.
- 2) There should not be any use of loudspeakers or any instrument of such kind, which causes public fury or cause inconvenience of any kind to commuting public.
- 3) The display material should not in any way offend public taste. There shall not be any sort of obscenity in the design and matter of the display material.
- 4) The code of conduct of the personnel's as well as the display material should in no way be exhibiting any religious or political vendetta.
- 5) The permission is valid subject to prior permission from the concerned GRP / RPF offices and the same should be handed over to Station Master
- 6) The personnel / volunteers engaged by the applicant should have valid entry permit /ticket on the railway premises.
- 7) The permission is granted up on the sole risk and cost of applicant only and no claim will be entertained on any kind of loss by railway administration.
- 8) Railway administration reserves the rights to modify or cancel the permission granted through a letter or a telephonic message to the In-charge of the station concerned.
- 9) No any kind of activity should be conducted on any FOB's of railway stations.
- 10) It should be at the corner where least movement of passengers.
- 11) It should be no cause of hindrance to the movement of passengers.
- 12) **Any kind of money transaction is strictly prohibited.**
- 13) The donation camp or canvassing shall not be on any FOB or mass public area.
- 14) All precautions, social distancing and government norms to be taken care of.
- 15) All Govt protocols, for COVID-19 should be maintained and it to be ensured that passengers are not put to inconvenience.


Necessary action will be initiated if any of these instructions are not complied. The railway administration reserves the right to revoke and amend permission at any time deemed proper.



**Subject: Report on Kokan Flood Relief 2021 and other Flood Relief activities by Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce.**

Maharashtra College has been actively involved in relief work since 2018. In 2018 we supported Kerala Flood Relief by collecting around Rs.23, 00,000/ (Twenty Three Lakhs Only) in cash and kind. I had updated your office on the same vide letter dated 20 October 2018. In 2019 we supported Maharashtra and Karnataka Flood Relief by collecting around Rs.9, 00,000/ (Rupees Nine Lakhs Only) in cash and kind. In 2020 the College supported the Kokan Nisarga Cyclone Relief Fund and Covid Relief Fund by collecting around Rs.7, 50,000/ (Rupees Seven Lakhs and Fifty Thousand Only) in cash and kind. We also contributed Rs. 1, 00,000/ (Rupees One Lakh Only) towards purchase and distribution of 50 Green Boards for 9 affected College in Konkan region in association with the Association of Non-Government Colleges, Mumbai.


We are tied up through an MOU with Anjuman Dardmandane - Talim - O - Taraqqi Trust, Mahad which is a well established NGO in Konkan to work together during calamities across India.

In 2021 Kokan was once again hit by flood on the night of 22 July 2021. Our college immediately formed a Relief Committee to collect funds and relief materials. As usual the NSS and the NCC Units took up the task along with the entire college students, staff and alumni association.

Over a period of over one month we were able to collect Rs.10, 66,059/ (Rupees Ten Lakhs Sixty Six Thousand and Fifty Nine) in cash and kind. We also were able to support the construction of a widow's house in Suvad village of Poladpur Taluka. We also donated Rs.1, 00,000/ (Rupees One Lakh Only) towards Kolhapur Flood Relief.

I take this opportunity to put on record the active participation of the student, staff and the alumni in the community outreach programs by the College especially during the times of calamities. The management has always supported and applauded the college active participation and contribution.

**Types of Marine Pollution**  
**Eutrophication/Nutrient Pollution**

1. Nutrient load up: excessive nutrients from fertilizers are flushed from the land into rivers or lakes by rainwater.

2. Plants flourish: these pollutants cause aquatic plant growth of algae, duckweed and other plants.

3. Algal blooms, oxygen is depleted: algal blooms, preventing sunlight reaching other plants. The plants die and oxygen in the water is depleted.

4. Decomposition further depletes oxygen: dead plants are broken down by bacteria decomposers, using up even more oxygen in the water.

5. Death of the ecosystem: oxygen levels reach a point where no life is possible. Fish and other organisms die.
