Rohit Tak Senior Project Associate from WRI India gave his inputs on how we could use the outer space for sitting, parking and pedestrian use.

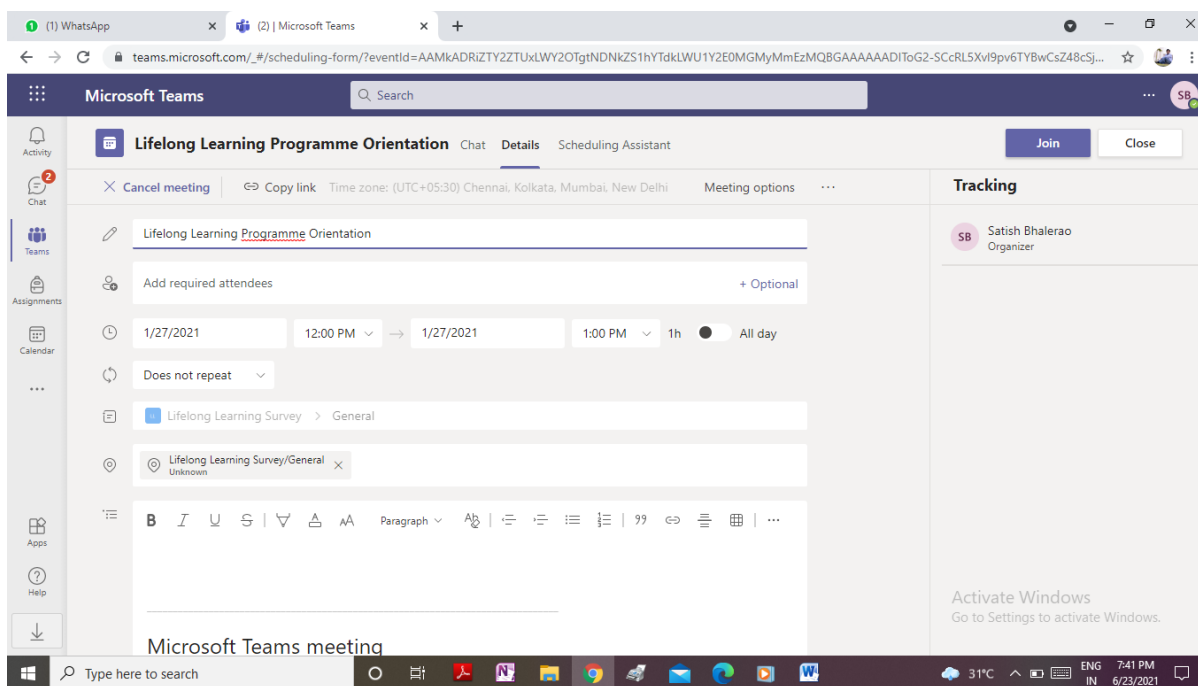

The speaker began with Introduction of MOHAN Foundation and covered various topics including types of Death, concept of organ donation, concept of tissue donation, process of organ donation, laws, myths & beliefs, advances in transplant, helpline number, etc. She also appealed students to become a donor and they join for the cause by becoming organ donation ambassador. Dr. Jimmy Gupta pointed that India needs 3 organ donors per million populations but currently the ratio is down to 0.50 persons per million. Around 70% of them are female-mother, sister giving their organ to needy relative. The state of Maharashtra alone requires 5 lakh Kidney donors at present. In Spain every body is donor – by government regulation. Such thing is difficult in India due to heterogeneous faiths and belief so we have to work on such awareness session, speaker suggested. She also pointed that Organ donation uncomfortable subject in India and counseling should be done in calm environment and not in ICU. She asked participants to spread the word.

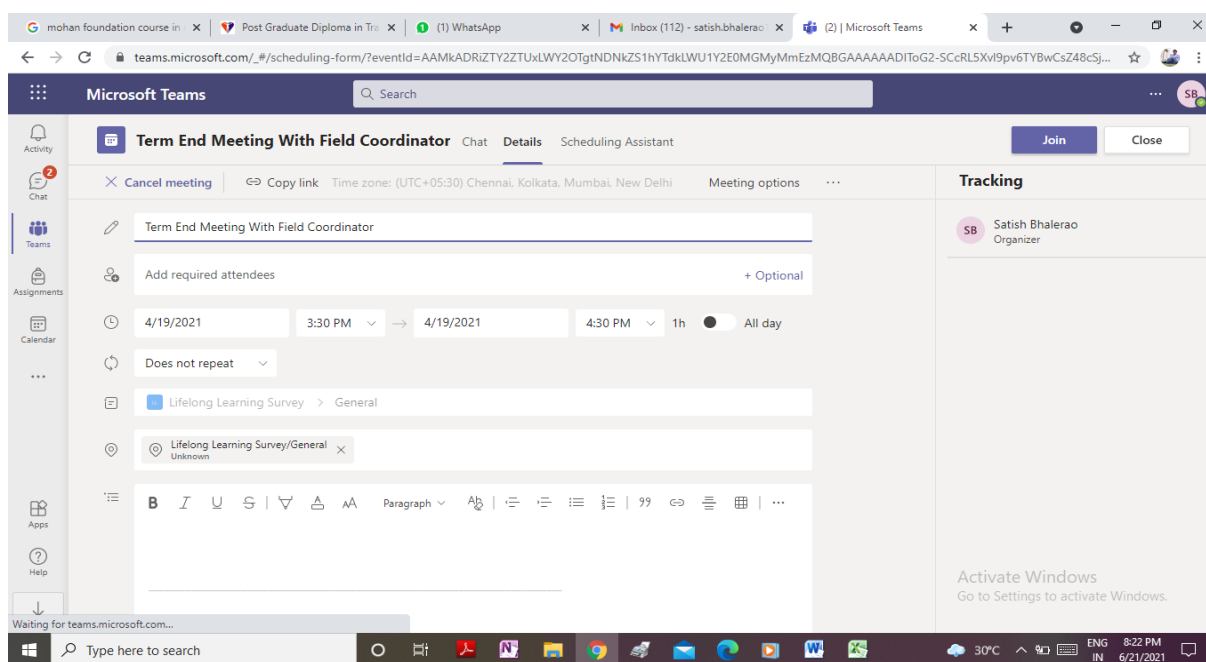
The speaker explained difference between coma and brain death. Brain death is an irreversible damage. Such person can donate 62 different parts, an over a llustration in image.

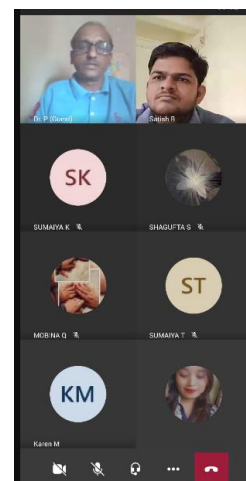
